**3. TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING**

The minutes of the last meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2018 were approved and signed as a correct record.

**4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE LAST MEETING**

**a) Speeding Traffic on Bradwall Road**

Cllr. Moran has notified the parish council that a traffic speed/count will take place on Bradwall Road in February. Two locations will be assessed, these are believed to be near Springbank Cottages in Bradwall and then further in to town near the Rugby Club/Barlow Way.

**b) Highways**

The condition of the road past the village hall has been reported to Cheshire East Highways, they have examined the area and say it “will be considered for inclusion in an appropriate future programme” however they are unable to give a timescale for this. They will continue to monitor.

**c) Street Light at Hollins Green**

The Clerk reported that the faulty street light at Hollins Green (side of number 12 on drive to numbers 14 & 16) was reported to Cheshire East, but this light is not on their list identifying lights they maintain. They referred us to Dane Housing, but when they were contacted they also said it’s not their responsibility. The Clerk will continue to chase this around and if necessary ask CE to repair and invoice BPC.

**5. FINANCE (Clerk)**

**6. PLANNING MATTERS**

**a) Outstanding Applications.**

18/477D Whitening House Cottage – Discharge of condition 4 on approved application 17/0610C. No decision.

18/4827C Hollinswood Farm – Conversion of Barns to create three new dwellings, including garages. Approved with conditions on 30/11/18.

18/5004C Chesworth Farm – Conversion of existing triple garage into self-contained ancillary accommodation. Approved with conditions on 6/12/18.

18/5002C Chesworth Farm – Demolish existing outbuildings and replace with extension.  
Approved with conditions on 10/12/18.

**b) New Applications.**

18/6425C 3 School Farm Court – Listed building consent for replacement hardwood windows, internal alterations, tv aerial and rooflight. Registered 8/01/19. No comments or observations.

**7. CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED (Clerk)**

- J Middlewich Bypass – Planned timescales have been published. Construction to start in summer of 2020 with the aim of opening winter 2021. Cost currently £58 million.

- J It was noted that former Parish Council member and Chairman, John C. K. Elliott MBE had died at the end of December. Cllr. Williams represented the Parish Council at the funeral and the Clerk has sent a letter of condolence to his widow and family.
- J The purchase of a defibrillator using money from the community benefit fund was discussed. It was agreed that this would be a good idea and it could be installed at the village hall. The Clerk was asked to research and bring costs to the next meeting, this should include the defibrillator, installation and training.
