The Chairman reported that yet again it had been a relatively quiet year for the council. The major concern and frustration has been the state of the roads and the lack of action from Cheshire East Council to carry out effective repairs. A traffic survey undertaken in February 2019 did highlight the volumes of traffic using the roads, particularly at "rush hour" times. However is was shown that the speed of the traffic is generally not excessive and is self-limiting. There have been relatively few planning applications submitted over the past year and there was nothing of concern to the council. The council income was healthy and the solar farm community benefit fund had been used to establish the community orchard. Three new dog waste bins have also been purchased and installed. Further ideas on how to use the monies from the community benefit fund would be welcomed. The Chairman thanked the Clerk for her work, Katrina Gnyp for maintaining the website and the Councillors for attending the meetings and their support over the past year.

Finally, it was noted with regret, that former member and Chairman, John C. K. Elliott MBE formerly of Bradwall House, passed away at the beginning of the year.
